

1 Installing Prolog

Make sure you are ssh-ed into andrew for this installation.

Run the scripts `/afs/andrew/course/15/317/317setup` and `/afs/andrew/course/15/317/bin/gprolog`.

You should be able to run `gprolog` afterwards. Something like

should appear.
